GUIDELINES FOR GENERAL APPLICANTS:

- 1. You are free to choose the size of submission.
- Classification of size is as follows: Category I: 140 x 140 x 30 cm. or smaller. Category II: between 40 x 140 x 30 cm. and 205 x 205 x 30 cm. Category III: between 205 x 205 x 30 cm. and 300 x 300 x 30 cm.
- * Please include Category III frame measurements.
- * Thickness of the frame should not be more than 5 cm.
- 3. There is no restriction on the number of entries submitted, but submitting several pieces as one entry is not permitted.
- 4. Application fee:
- Fee for one entry in any category is \$12,000.
- Fee for subsequent entries in Category I is 4,000.
- Fee for subsequent entries in Category II is 46,000.
- Fee for subsequent entries in Category III is \$8,000.
- If the entries straddle more than one category, the fee for the highest category is applied to all entries.
- 5. Submission of multiple entries must be made at the same time.

GUIDELINES FOR YOUNG APPLICANTS AND FOREIGNERS LIVING OVERSEAS: 1.

Anyone under the age of 30 is qualified to apply.

There is no age limit for overseas applicants, but the following restrictions should be observed. Overseas applicants should arrange for a Japanese agent to represent them in Japan.

- Shinseisaku will not arrange or recommend agents.
- The agent is responsible for load-in and load-out, transportation, and insurance of the work.
- The agent will be notified if the work receives an award.
- The agent will be notified of new load-out guidelines for awarded works.
- 2. The size is Unlimited. But it is within size of the elevator. (Inquiry required)
- 3. If the artwork deviates from regulation, contact Shinseisaku for permission before submitting.

4. Submission of art work:

- A minimum of 2 entries is required.
- More than 2 entries may be submitted
- Single entries containing several parts must be submitted at the same time.

5. Application deadline: Tuesday, August 12. Please submit your work on Google Forms.

- 6. There is no application fee.
- 7. There is a \$12,000 exhibition fee (which includes a copy of the exhibition catalog) if the artwork is accepted.

FRAMING:

Painting frame should not be more than 5 cm. thick.

Glass cover is not permitted; acrylic cover is acceptable.

Mark on the back of the painting with an up-arrow (\uparrow) to indicate the top.

Attach the Entry Form on the upper right corner of the back.

- Applicant will be given a Submission Receipt for each entry.
- This Submission Receipt must be kept by the applicant as it will be required at load-out.
- Consignment Delivery
- Applicant must give the Application Form, a copy of the Application Fee Receipt and the artwork with the Entry Form attached to the consigned transportation company.

REJECTION OF ARTWORK

Rejection of Artwork

- Artwork will not be accepted if: (HANDLING OF ARTWORK)
- it may cause odor, rot, mold or attract insects; it contains hazardous material;
- it contains live animal and plants used in the artwork without suitable countermeasures.

LOAD-OUT

- Location: National Art Center, B1, Shinseisaku Exhibition Reception.
- Load-out for rejected artwork: Saturday, September 13. September 14 Sunday 10:00-17:00
- Load-out for accepted artwork: Tuesday, September 30. October 1 Wednesday 10:00-15:00
- Direct Pickup: Present the Submission Receipt at Shinseisaku Reception.
- Consignment Pickup: Another person or agency must show both the Submission receipt and a copy of the Application Fee Receipt.
- Strict adherence to load-out time period must be observed.

Note:

- Submission Receipt must be shown in order to pickup the artwork.
- In the case of consigned load-out, contact your handling agent directly.
- Artwork left after the load-out date will be stored in Yachuda Bijutsu Art Co. warehouse. The artist will be responsible for the storage fee.
- Shinseisaku Association is no longer responsible for the artwork after the load-out date.
- There is a 2-hour parking limit for load-out.

FILMING

- Permission from Shinseisaku and the National Art Center is necessary for any filming to take place.

REPRODUCTION OF ARTWORK IN THE EXHIBITION

- Rights to all exhibitions sponsored by Shinseisaku (including records of exhibition works, posting on printed matter, television broadcasting) belong to Shinseisaku.
